Purpose/Role: Lab/Studio Monitor

**Job Description/Responsibilities**: Student worker Studio and Lab Monitors are responsible for helping students with class projects (within reason) and the proper use of equipment, light maintenance and cleaning, being present for their work hours, overall supervision of the lab/studio space (including reminding students of studio or lab rules), and other duties specific to the studio or lab they work in.

## Lab/Studio Monitor Responsibilities

- To provide light cleaning and maintenance of the lab/studio space and equipment.
- To assist students with class projects and proper use of equipment.
- To be on time for their shift, stay for the duration of their shift and attend to lab/studio needs **before** spare time is used for homework or personal projects.
- To adhere to similar absence polices as are instated in class: Three absence are grounds for reevaluation.
- To attend a minimum of four hours training by the second week of the semester.
- To log all work hours accurately within IAIA's Paylocity system.

**General Qualifications**: Student worker Studio and Lab Monitor positions are granted to students that have proven themselves to be responsible and interested in the running and operation of a lab/studio space.
