Purpose/Role:

To support student use of studios after class hours. The work study program is for the purpose of training and enhancing educational goals, students are expected to be working members of the department, receiving an hour's pay for an hour's work.

Job Description/Responsibilities:

Student Worker will;

- keep the studio clean daily and ready for use in a health and safe manner.
- keep a log of all job tasks as well as hours worked.
- open the studios during set times.
- should have ability to lift at least 50 lbs.
- assist students with course/studio related work e.g., stretch/gesso canvas, etc.
- additional duties may be assigned by the instructor or studio technician.
- post studio-monitor hours at studio entrances within first week of work.

General Qualifications:

- Must be registered in these courses: **Painting or Drawing**
- Have familiarity with the Painting and Drawing studios (must be able to migrate between painting and drawing studios during work hours).
- Must be an effective communicator.
- Reliability is a must and able to work varied shifts to support open studio hours – preferably evenings and possibly weekends.
