Job Description/Responsibilities:

Under regular guidance:

- Production work including ushering, greeting and house management. Will include some lifting of up to 30 lbs
- Supervise fellow student volunteers and work with visiting artists
- Maintain a professional demeanour as a representative of IAIA and the Performing Arts Department

- Some evening and week-end hours required
- Assist as needed in all areas of performing arts
