drawing, and printmaking

Guidelines:

- 1. All current IAIA students are eligible to enter.
- 2. Only one entry per category (13 categories) per artist but there is no limit on the number of categories entered.
- 3. Artwork must have been created within the last 2 years.
- 4. Size restrictions (for transportation purposes):

 The maximum size for all artwork is 2'x 2'

 Textiles/Quilts: must be able to fold for storage and transportation.
- 5. Winning artworks will be submitted into the American Indian Higher Education Consortium Art Competition in Albuquerque (March 21-24).
- 6. All artwork MUST be ready for display.
- 7. A jury panel will judge all entries.
- 8. IAIA Art Competition submission form, AIHEC art competition form, and artwork must be complete at time of entry.
- 9. Submissions will only be accepted on Feb. 24 and Feb. 25th, from 9am until 5pm. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 10. All entires marked "for sale" must be accompained by a signed letter by the artist stating permission for the sale of the item/s. Please include: title, price, signature, address, and direct contact info. Letters must be submitted at time of artwork intake.
- 11. The artist must **complete a separate IAIA submission form** for each piece of artwork that is submitted.
- 12. Winning entries must remain with the Balzer Gallery for the duration of the IAIA competition and the AIHEC Art Competition in order to be eligible for awards.
