A-i-R will hold ZOOM sessions that include critiques. Lara plans to roll out the sessions in late July or early August. A-i-R will also hold panel discussions online.

Danyelle Means said that she wants to promote the Scholarship event in August via social media.

Eric stated that the committee will start discussing how events will take place on campus. Jason stated that we should still use the community calendar that is posted on the website and on the TV screens across campus.

Paul Moore asked if we will have #ManyNationsOneFamily t-shirts available. Eric said that the printmaking studio is closed and that they will not be able to produce t-shirts.

Shelley Patrick asked if students can have their own IAIA social media accounts, specifically for ASG. Eric told Shelley that she and ASG will need to give admin access to MARCOM for all social media accounts.
