Purpose/Role:

Job Description/Responsibilities/Abilities:

Assists MoCNA's Collection Department in the day-to-day operations of managing and working in the museum collection's art storage housed on the IAIA campus. Duties involve handling works of art, cataloguing, condition reporting, filing, database entry, and housekeeping.
