#### **Arts & Craft Booth Fees:**

**Booth Fee**: \$25 deposit or Art piece (returned if present at Powwow) – IAIA student

**Booth Fee:** \$50.00 + 1 raffle item donation – Faculty, Staff and Alumni

**Booth Fee:** \$75.00 + 1 raffle item donation – Outside vendor, must be Native American

**Student Clubs and IAIA Departments -** Booth Fee is waived but an application must be completed.

Booth Fee: Registration form must be completed prior Powwow. <u>Booth fee</u> <u>must be paid at the Powwow to claim a space</u>. No advance payments will be accepted. Checks, cash or money order will be accepted with completed application. (No refunds on cancelations) Make checks payable to the: **IAIA Powwow Club**.

**Booth Size:** One six-foot table with two chairs will be provided. If you are bringing your own display table, or tent, this must be indicated on the Registration Form and it must fit in the space allocated. Due to limited space, only one normal size pop-up style vendor tent will be allowed per registration.

**Set up time: 8:00am – Noon**. Vendors are responsible for their own merchandise, loading and unloading. All sales are between vendor and customer. Please unload by the circle drop off area near the flag pole. Vehicles **must** park after unloading. **Do not leave vehicles in circle area drop off area.**

#### **Powwow Rules for Arts & Craft Vendors**

We are pleased that you are interested in being an Arts & Craft vendor for the 2016 Spring Homecoming Powwow, on Saturday May 9, 2016. Please read the enclosed information and complete the enclosed Vendor contract and return it to us as soon as possible. It is required for your participation at the powwow.

Full payment is required at the time of set up. Please remember that, due to limited space, all booth assignments are final and no special requests will be accommodated. Booth space will be provided on a first come, first serve basis. It can, at times, be very sunny, windy and warm at the Powwow, so please plan accordingly.

### **General Information - Arts & Crafts Booth Vendors:**

#### Booth Vendors

You can only sell premade food that is not in conflict with the student club concessions. We will provide you with a list from the clubs. You are allowed to sell anything that is not on their menu. Artwork must be hand made by the vendor. No bought items for resale are allowed. No household or "garage sale" items.

#### Student Clubs

If you are utilizing the booth as a fundraiser all sales from the booth or for a raffle or other fundraising must take place at your booth. You are not permitted to sell away from your space, as you will be in direct competition of the Powwow committee raffle.

#### Information Booth – Free

You are welcome to provide information regarding your organization. You are not able to sell anything. To sell merchandise of any type, including fundraising, would require payment of the full vendor fee.

Thank you for your support of our powwow and hope you enjoy your time with us. If you are not able to attend the powwow, please notify us of your cancellation as soon as possible.
