### **APPLICANT INFORMATION**

The Inter-Tribal Council of AT&T Employees (ICAE) has developed the 2018 Fall Scholarship Program as a way of reaching back into local communities to financially assist Native American students in continuing their higher education. We are pleased to announce that the 2018 program has maintained the same level of funding as our 2017 awards and will include: 21 - \$1,000 scholarships, 6 - \$500 scholarships and 3 - \$2,000 scholarships!

The ICAE Scholarship Program will issue scholarship grants to qualified Native American applicants who are selected primarily for their individual merit. Eligibility requirements will be used to initially screen applications for completeness prior to the actual review process. High School students accepted at, or College students enrolled in an accredited <u>undergraduate</u> program are eligible to apply. Candidates must be U.S. Citizens or Permanent Residents.

After the initial screening process, all eligible candidates will be evaluated based on their scholastic discipline, personal achievement, and community involvement. The ICAE Scholarship Committee based on a uniform, weighted point average system will select scholarship winners collectively.

#### **Deadline extended to November 17<sup>th</sup>!!**

Those selected from the eligible applications postmarked by November 2, 2018, will receive either \$2,000, \$1,000 or \$500 in award money to use toward his or her higher education. Previous recipients are eligible to re-apply. Results will be announced by November 30 with checks being disbursed to the institutions by mid-December.

Please complete the attached application and mail to the address below along with a letter of recommendation. Please request your high school or University to mail a copy of your transcript to the same address. The application and all required components must be *postmarked* by November 2, 2018.
